



Two separate evaluations, one for As Designed potential (asset rating) and the other for In Operation performance (operational rating), form the foundation of Building EQ.





Chiller Star Labelling Program - The program was formulated by Bureau of Energy Efficiency (BEE). It envisages providing star rating in terms of its energy performance. The program will be mandatory from 1st Jan 2021. BEE has developed online registration platform for easy and expeditious approval under this program. It will allow manufacturers to register online for availing appropriate star rating of chiller equipment. Based on test certificate from designated agencies and after due verification from BEE, star label on the scale of 1 (less efficient) to 5 (most efficient).

Significance of star labeling of chillers - It will help promote advancement technology for central HVAC (Heating, ventilation & air conditioning) systems and will also facilitate energy efficient solutions for large commercial and industrial applications. It will also help to save more than 500 million units of electricity along with Green House Gases reduction of 0.5 million-ton equivalent of Co2. It will also save more than 4 billion units of electricity by 2030 with Co2 emission reduction of 3.5 million ton.
